TROUT HANDLING & RELEASE ADVICE

PLAN AHEAD

Know the regulations and bring pliers or a release tool

LAND QUICKLY

Use appropriate tackle and do not play a fish to exhaustion

MINIMIZE HANDLING

Keep the fish in the water while removing the hook and taking photographs

RELEASE WHEN READY

Allow the fish to revive and swim away on its own power



OTHER TIPS:

- Use single-hook lures, or circle hooks if fishing bait (when bait is legal), and cut the line if the fish is deeply hooked
- If a fish must be handled, use wet hands or a rubberized knotless net, and support the fish horizontally
- Fish during cooler parts of the day in summer
- When legal, consider harvesting severely injured or exhausted fish
