

Keep this range free and open to the public by following these range rules

- Hearing and eye protection MUST be used at all times by shooters and spectators.
- Visitors may not be under the influence of or in possession of alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances.
- All firearms MUST be unloaded and properly holstered or cased when entering or leaving the range. Firearms may not be loaded until on the firing range.
- Paper targets or clay targets ONLY must be used. Hang targets on fence.
- NO explosive targets, tracer rounds, fully automatic, .50 Browning Machine Gun (BMG) or 12.7x99 mm NATO firearms allowed.
- No firing from points other than permanent bench rests.
- All firearms will be unloaded and actions open while targets are being hung and or checked. **Do not handle firearms while someone is down range!**
- Stand behind the bench rest while targets are being hung or checked.
- No person under the age of 16 may shoot unless accompanied by an adult (age 21 or older) who is responsible for the minor's actions.
- Do not run on range keep off berms.
- Do not sit or climb on top of bench rests.
- Remove all targets from fence and clean up your area, including brass, after you have finished shooting.

Remember the Basics of Firearm Safety:

1. **Control your muzzle: Keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction.**
2. **Treat every firearm as if it were loaded.**
3. **Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.**
4. **Keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot.**

You and you alone are responsible for the projectile that leaves your firearm.
